Home Cozy Tip 1: Start With Cozy Elements



Element	Description	Impact
Soft Textures	Using blankets, pillows, and rugs made from materials like fleece, wool, or chunky knits to add layers of warmth and comfort. Velvet and faux fur offer tactile experiences, while rugs anchor furniture and soften surfaces.	Contributes to emotional well-being by creating a warm, tactile environment that encourages relaxation.
Warm Lighting	Replacing harsh overhead lights with ambient sources like table lamps, floor lamps, and dimmer switches. Warm color temperature bulbs (around 2700K) and candles emulate a soft glow, enhancing the cozy atmosphere.	Promotes feelings of happiness and relaxation, influencing the overall ambiance of a home.
Natural Elements	Adding houseplants, natural wood furniture, woven baskets, and jute or seagrass accents to connect the home with nature. Easy-care plants like pothos and snake plants are beginner-friendly options.	Improves mood, reduces stress levels, and supports a healthier and more peaceful lifestyle.
