

Your Guide to Removing Stubborn Stains



Surface	Common Stains	Suggested Solutions
Stone Countertops	Wine, Coffee, Oil	- Use baking soda and water paste for granite. - Apply baking soda paste or hydrogen peroxide for marble. - Use non-abrasive cleaner or soapy water for quartz.
Solid Surface Countertops	Colorful Food Stains	- Clean with soapy water and a soft cloth. - For tougher stains, use a mild abrasive cleaner in circular motions. - Avoid harsh chemicals or scouring pads.
Wood Flooring	Watermarks, Ink, Grease	- Buff light watermarks with mineral spirits or toothpaste. - Sand dark stains lightly and reapply finish. - Apply a poultice for grease or use isopropyl alcohol for ink stains.
Carpets & Rugs	Pet Stains, Coffee, Wine	- Blot spills immediately with a clean cloth. - Use a vinegar-water solution for pet stains. - Apply a baking soda paste, allow to dry, and vacuum for coffee or wine stains.
Tiles	Grout Discoloration	- Use a baking soda and water paste with a stiff brush. - Apply oxygen-based bleach for tougher stains. - Regular grout sealing prevents future stains.
Other Surfaces	Hard Water, Rust, Food Stains	- Spray white vinegar for hard water stains on glass. - Use lemon juice and salt paste for rust on metal. - Soak plastic in water and bleach or vinegar for food stains.
