

Trees That Thrive in an All-Season Sunroom



Tree Type	Ideal Conditions	Highlights
Ficus Trees	Bright, indirect sunlight; temperatures above 55–60°F; avoid relocation to prevent leaf drop.	Highly adaptable; lush foliage; rewards consistent care in sunrooms.
Citrus Trees	6–12 hours of sunlight; temperatures between 65°F–75°F; well-draining soil; winter supplemental lighting may be needed.	Fragrant blossoms; edible fruit; popular varieties include Meyer lemon and calamondin orange.
Olive Trees	At least 6 hours of direct sunlight; dry, well-draining soil; moderate watering once a week.	Low-maintenance; Mediterranean aesthetic; tolerates dry indoor air.
Avocado Trees	6 or more hours of bright light; temperatures of 60°F–85°F; evenly moist, well-draining soil.	Lush, dramatic foliage; rarely produces fruit indoors but adds vibrant greenery.
Fig Trees	Full sun; consistent moisture during growth; tolerates dry periods once established.	Produces edible fruit; compact varieties like Fignomenal® Dwarf Fig are practical for small spaces.
